All training courses can be arranged as refreshment training either as an independent refreshment course or as a combination of different courses. The number of training days may vary according to the customer's needs.

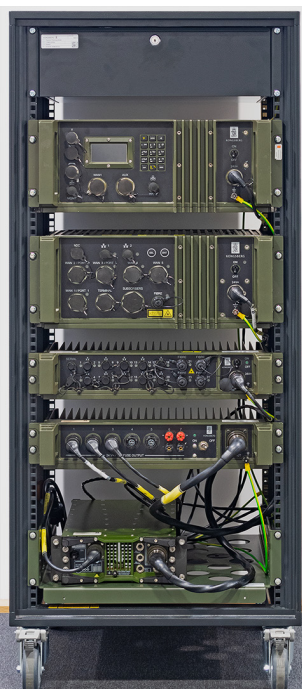
Role based Training

TRAINING COURSES OVERVIEW

Operator Training	Basic training in operation of one or several products, systems or system components
Network Administrator Training	Builds on Operator Training. Covers configuration, operation and operational fault-finding on system components and in the communication system
Maintenance Training	Builds on Operator Training. Covers maintenance routines, technical fault-finding and change of main components on products and systems
System Training	Builds on previous courses. Practical use in a fully operational system where all functions and roles are in operation
